REGISTRARS – CBC 4 ALL

We hope you have at least heard about the **CBC 4 All** program being conducted June 2 through Aug 1, 2008. Attached are the 4 bulletins (numbers [one](#), [two](#), [three](#), [four](#)) that have been sent previously to your Scout Executive. Bulletin #5 will include screen shots.

On or about June 2nd, a letter will be sent to approximately 220,000 volunteers who have here-to-fore been “grandfathered” in, and have not been subjected to a Criminal Background Check. The process will have these volunteers go to a web site to grant authorization. When THEY press the **SUBMIT** button, it will drop into **YOUR** submit file (sort of like online recharter).

That is why you need to submit CBCs **DAILY** this summer, to avoid a bottleneck (bulletin #2).

The file of 220,000 names was pulled on **Thursday May 15, 2008**. Your SE has access to the list of volunteers in your council who will be receiving a letter. It can be accessed via the CBC gadget on the Scout Executive's MyBSA page. **Note:** if you have not cleaned up your name merge list, THERE WILL BE DUPLICATES. Please review this list for names you might already have cleared in the CBC process. Between now and June 2, please merge the duplicate leaders in your council.

If a volunteer clicks “decline” by mistake, they are directed to call Dorothy Jackson (at Registration Service), who will reset their account.
