### **WAYCROSS CAMP TOLOCHEE UNDERGOES RENOVATIONS**

Camp Tolochee was opened in the early 1950s as a summer camp for the Okefenokee Area Council in Waycross, GA. After years of use the camp is beginning to take on a worn and weathered look, so the council's leadership is working to change that.

Projects include a new swimming pool, health lodge, ropes course, archery range, and aquatic equipment. Major renovations to the rifle range and dining hall are also part of the plan. The campaign has received a lead gift of \$300,000 and a second major gift of \$75,000, plus many other gifts.
